### **ENSEMBLE TWO 2018**

Fourteen young artists are currently working with writers and theatre makers David Burton and Emily Burton to create a work about adulthood, and the transition from youth to being in your early twenties – there are imaginary friends and talking bears. It will be presented at La Boite in November 2018.

### **ENSEMBLE ONE 2019**

Ensemble One participants in 2019 will bring to life David Burton's new play *The Final Days* of *Bedlam* which is about an imaginary version of today, where all state schools shut down, and only a privileged few are allowed to attend elite schools.

We're hoping that school audiences from Grades 7-10 will attend the production of this show.

### THE FINAL DAYS OF BEDLAM BY DAVID BURTON

It's the final few days of school...EVER. Audiences are thrust into a fictional version of today where school is no longer compulsory, in fact school for most young people will no longer exist. A group of students at Bedlam High contemplate what this means for them and what they want next. Do they even want to go to school? Should they start their own school? What do they want to learn? What will the world be like without school? The only thing that's certain is these last few days are complete bedlam.

The Final Days of Bedlam is a play written for young people to ponder the role of the classroom, their power and politics, and what learning means.

### **ENSEMBLE TWO 2019**

Ensemble Two will create a collaborative and devised work with an outstanding local professional artist. It will privilege the ideas of the whole ensemble and encourage participants to develop theatre making, idea generation, devising, writing, improvisation, collaboration and performance skills.

This ensemble isn't just for performers, if you're interested in writing, directing or production artistry – roles will be created for you.

WE ARE INTERESTED IN LEARNING ABOUT YOU, YOUR TALENT, WHAT YOU ARE CURIOUS ABOUT, WHAT YOU WANT TO LEARN, THE THEATRE YOU LOVE AND WANT TO MAKE, THE ARTIST YOU ARE AND WANT TO BE.

### PREPARING FOR YOUR AUDITION

Each Ensemble will be made up of 12-15 young artists who are interested in collaborating to create a new theatre work, this will mean performing, writing and devising.

We are interested in learning about you, your talent, what you are curious about, what you want to learn, the theatre you love and want to make, the artist you are and want to be.

You will participate in a workshop audition – meaning there will be other auditionees in the space with you as you work. You will be asked to complete some improvisations, or some scene work, and to collaborate with your peers in the space. We also ask that you prepare a two minute piece to perform.

## PREPARE: [2 MINUTES] THIS IS YOUR OPPORTUNITY TO SHOW US WHAT YOU CAN DO - PERFORM A MONOLOGUE, A POEM, A SONG; ANYTHING THAT BEST REFLECTS WHO YOU ARE AND WHAT SKILLS YOU HAVE.

Young people who do not wish to perform but would love to participate in creative roles such as directing, writing, design and technical roles must complete the workshop component of the audition – but they won't need to perform a prepared piece. Instead you might like to show us your writing, artwork, or speak to us about what inspires you, what kind of designer or artist you are and the work you'd like to make.

### THINGS TO REMEMBER:

Auditions may seem scary – but they're really not. They are an opportunity for the creative team to get to know you. We understand you might feel nervous, but it's important to remember that auditions are a small window of time where we can get to know you and what you're interested in, so come prepared and be honest.

Remember: We're excited to meet you and we want you to do well.


