Open to highschool aged students (12-17yo), our Young Artist Company will be performing Steve Pirie's *3 O'Clock, Flagpole*.


3 O'CLOCK, FLAGPOLE

It's the first day of a new school year for Stella Bunt and everything is changing. New rules, new teacher, new responsibilities. To make matters worse for Stella and the rest of Year 10 Biology, they have a new class pet, Squish the octopus. Stella can't explain why, but there's just something about Squish that doesn't feel right. When Squish goes missing and a terrifying new kid arrives at school the very next day, Stella suspects they might be connected in some way.

3 O'Clock, Flagpole is a new magical realism work that jumps straight into the quadrangle to pull apart classroom politics, safety and a world where students must figure it out on their own.

PREPARING FOR YOUR AUDITION

We are looking for 12-15 young artists who are interested in collaborating to create a new theatre work, this will mean performing, devising and working as an ensemble.

We are interested in learning about you, your talent, what you are curious about, what you want to learn, the theatre you love and want to make, the artist you are and want to be.

You will have ten minutes to show us the following:

TASK ONE - MONOLOGUE

[1-2 minutes] Prepare a monologue. We can provide you an excerpt from 3 O'Clock, Flagpole, or you can use a monologue from school or another play that you'd wish to perform. Learn it off by heart, and practice presenting it. You will be performing the monologue to us in the audition. We'd prefer that you present it without script in hand. We will have someone to prompt the lines if needed.

TASK TWO - SCENE

[2-3 minutes] We'll send you a partner scene from 3 O'Clock, Flagpole. Familiarise yourself with the scene. You don't need to know this scene off by heart. You will be running the scene with one of us reading the other lines in the room. It is up to you which character you play. We will give you a copy of the script to read off of when you present it in the audition. During this run, we may give you some small directions to try certain things out, just like a mini rehearsal.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

This is a relaxed audition process. We want you to have fun, show off your best skills, as well as your personality. Yes we are looking at your performing skills, but we are also looking for people who we think will work well together and who will positively contribute to the rehearsal room. We want you to enjoy yourself, so don't let nerves get in the way.
