writer, **Alinta McGrady**, this wild, unapologetic horror-comedy is about what we fight for, even when the world has fallen down. Full throttle, full heart.

Rebirth. Reckoning. A new start on Mars. La Boite welcomes back beloved Brisbane writer **Kathryn Marquet** with **SECOND COMING**, the third installament in her eco-feminist triptych, following acclaimed La Boite seasons of *Pale Blue Dot* and *The Dead Devils* of *Cockle Creek*. A love song to planet Earth, *Second Coming* explores the rise of corporate power, and the need for new ethics in a time of boundless capitalism. If we refuse to learn from our mistakes on Earth, are we destined to repeat them on Mars?

We round out the season with a dish of longing, family and home with **KOREABOO** by **Michelle Lim Davidson**. Hannah had her trip all planned out. Travel to Korea. Visit her birth mother. Spend a golden summer creating precious memories. But when she arrives in Seoul reality hits hard. Antigone explodes onto the Roundhouse stage with raw energy and unflinching relevance.

A dynamic interpretation of Sophocles' timeless tragedy, centered on a fearless young woman who refuses to stay silent.

When Antigone defies the king's command to leave her brother unburied, she ignites a brutal clash between personal conviction and authoritarian power.

This is no dusty myth. It's a charged story of protest, conscience, and defiance, set against a backdrop of political turmoil that feels both ancient and alarmingly current.

Antigone's act of resistance sparks questions that burn with urgency today: Who gets to decide what is just? Where does loyalty lie? With the state, or with family, or with ourselves? And what price are we prepared to pay for the truth?

Visceral, poetic and uncompromising, this energetic reimagining of Antigone—directed by La Boite's Artistic Director Courtney Stewart (Macbeth, Congratulations, Get Rich!) and award-winning fight, movement and intimacy director Nigel Poulton (Closer, The Poison of Polygamy)—thrusts Sophocles' classic into the heart of our fractured world. Starring Maddison Burridge as Antigone, this three-hander production ignites a rallying cry for courage in the face of oppression.

The zombie apocalypse has finally happened and TikTok is the sole form of communication. This is a world of zombie kill tallies, educational doomsday TikToks, and out-of-bounds Bunnings.

Sheree and Tash are bunking down in a bowling alley, when another survivor turns up, challenging their isolation.

Maybe it's time to explore who, and what else, is out there? With big decisions to make, and no working flamethrower to protect them, how do two Blak women navigate a world that is actively trying to kill them?

Eat Slay Zombie, co-directed by playwright, multidisciplinary artist, and Githabul–Migunberri–Yugumbeh woman Alinta McGrady, and Lisa Fa'alafi (Co-Artistic Director: Polytoxic, Hot Brown Honey), is a horror/comedy about colonisation, friendship, and state occupation — except it's zombies.


