Bringing this play to life with Dead Puppet Society has been an absolute delight. As a writer who has often been told 'that's too hard to stage' it's been liberating working with a team that leans into creative challenges. I've also thoroughly enjoyed having permission to use humour to tackle big ideas.

To stage this show at La Boite Theatre has been a homecoming dream. I cut my teeth in this Roundhouse, so to come back and make my mainstage writing debut here feels like I'm coming home - much more grown up than the 19 year old who wrangled props backstage.

We started working on this show in 2020. In that time, a lot has happened, but time and time again the premise of the work has been proven true - we are all going to die. As I write this in 2025, I'm not sure if it will be a cataclysmic upheaval of us all, or a slow whimpering to the finish line, but we are all going to die. The play didn't originally have this title. During a development in 2021, Matt Seery and I were workshopping alternatives and after he suggested WE'RE ALL GONNA DIE! nothing else compared.

This play does not point fingers to any individual, politician or party, but points out the fact that the institutions we're meant to trust to keep us safe have been ignoring the impending climate change crisis. Passing on the buck to the next lot who come through, only for the next lot to yet again pass down the buck.

I'm not suggesting that some silly play written by someone from Brisbane is going to save the world. But I hope, maybe, it reminds people that climate change is the one universal truth, the one monster that is coming for us all. If we don't grow up and figure out what we're going to do about it, then... well... read the title of the play.



She was a finalist in the Queensland Premier Drama Award in 2020-21, and was awarded the UNSW Faculty of Arts, Design and Architecture Dean's List (Postgraduate) award in both 2022 and 2023. She currently works as a journalist for The ABC, reporting on life in outback Queensland.

Courtney Stewart is an acclaimed director, dramaturg, actor and teaching artist with a deep passion for intercultural works and multicultural dramaturgies. She is the current Artistic Director and CEO of La Boite Theatre.

David is a writer, director and designer, and the Creative Director of Dead Puppet Society. Over the last sixteen years he has led Dead Puppet Society in the creation of large-scale designled theatre works developed with international teams.

Some highlights from work produced includes the Australian premiere of *Peter and the Starcatcher*, produced with JONES Theatrical Group, Glass Half Full and Damien Hewitt; *Holding Achilles*, which was supported through the Major Festivals Initiative and has had successful seasons with Brisbane and Sydney Festivals; *The Wider Earth* (Dead Puppet Society, Queensland Theatre, Trish Wadley Productions, Glass Half Full Productions), which was conceived in residence at St Ann's Warehouse in Brooklyn, New York City and enjoyed a six-month run in a custombuilt theatre in London's Natural History Museum; *Laser Beak Man* (Dead Puppet Society, La Boite Theatre, Brisbane Festival, PowerArts), which was a collaboration with Tim Sharp, developed at the New Victory Theater in New York City.

Additional works include Ishmael (Dead Puppet Society, Brisbane Festival, QPAC); The Riddle of Washpool Gully (Terrapin, Dead Puppet Society); Argus (Dead Puppet Society, Lincoln Centre, Queensland Theatre, Brisbane Powerhouse); Trollop (Queensland Theatre); and The Harbinger (Dead Puppet Society, La Boite Theatre, Critical Stages).

David has been nominated for five Helpmann Awards and an Olivier Award. He holds a Doctor of Philosophy in puppetry and visual theatre from Queensland University of Technology.




