ENSEMBLE TWO 2019

Ensemble Two will work with Director and Theatre Maker Matt Seery (Metro Arts, Dead Puppet Society, Imaginary Theatre) to re-imagine a contemporary text. This process will privilege the ideas of the whole ensemble and encourage participants to develop theatre making, idea generation, devising, collaboration and performance skills. This ensemble isn't just for performers, if you're interested in directing, production or design, roles can be created for you.

ABOUT YAC 2

The Young Artist Company will bring together an ensemble of up to 15 artists aged approx. 18 – 26 who are interested in staging a full-length contemporary theatre production. The Company will be made up of artists with various skillsets, interests and experiences; including actors, performers, writers, designers and more.

Our work together will revolve around a challenging, but playful contemporary text. We will pull it apart and re-assemble it in different ways, bending it this way and that to see what it can do. The text will be a launching point for conversation and sharing amongst our ensemble, as well the inspiration for new writing and original performance content we develop along the way.

Our work on character, performance and design will take place "on the floor" involving all members of the ensemble. Our process will be characterised by collaboration and experimentation: we will take nothing for granted and relish the opportunity to see what happens if we do this....

AUDITIONS

While we will be predominately working from an existing script, this project is designed to challenge expectations and question first instincts. As such, we are looking for teamplayers; adventurous theatre-makers with initiative and something to say.

Auditions will be a chance to demonstrate your skills, but more importantly are a chance for us to get to know each other. This is the time to share your interests, ask questions about the work we'll do together, and tell us what you hope to achieve or learn as part of the Young Artist Company.

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

Auditions may seem scary – but they're really not. They are an opportunity for the creative team to get to know you. We understand you might feel nervous, but it's important to remember that auditions are a small window of time where we can get to know you and what you're interested in, so come prepared and be honest.

Remember: We're excited to meet you and we want you to do well.

PREPARATION FOR YOUR AUDITION:

ACTORS / PERFORMERS

- → A short contemporary monologue of your choosing (approx. 2 minutes).
- → Familiarize yourself with the attached excerpt. Prepare to perform both characters over different readings with a fellow auditionee or reader. You should be comfortable with the text, but do not need to be off-book.

WRITERS. DESIGNERS, OTHER NON-PERFORMING ARTISTS

- → An example of your previous work for us to read / hear about / have a look at;
- → OR a response to the attached excerpt. This might be a short piece of original writing inspired by the excerpt, a description of how you envision the scene being presented onstage or something else.
- We are interested in getting a sense of your practice including style, methods and interests.


ALL AUDITIONEES:
